LETTER OF REFERENCE: Naylor Steeplejacks

To Whom it May Concern:

From July 15, 2001 though September 10, 2001 Roy Naylor of Naylor Steeplejacks repaired scraped and painted the steeple on the Old North Reformed Church of Dumont, New Jersey.

Our church is an historical marker as it was erected in 1801 and our steeple is the tallest and considered the most beautiful steeple in Bergen County. As such we were very careful when selecting a firm to do the necessary painting and repair. Now that the work is done I can truly state I have never seen the steeple look more beautiful than it does today.

We have had numerous comments from our consistory, our congregation, and local townspeople that the steeple has been restored to its original beauty and that they have never seen it so sparkling white. As well, the (3) rotten wooden columns below the steeple were restored to match the other columns identically.
